

DOYON UTILITIES TRANSITION UPDATE

Fort Richardson

- Substation components have arrived on site. (See picture below titled “Substation Components” - Marvin Riddle, Consultant with Riddle Consulting (on the left) and George Gordon, President of Doyon Utilities (on the right), inspect a portion of the substation on site.)
- Footings have been poured at the substation site.
- Underground work for the Operation Depot utilities has been installed under the depot pad area.
- The Operation Depot pad should be poured mid next week.
- The Operation Depot steel structure should be arriving late next week.
