

- For routine outages, Doyon Utilities requires a minimum of 16 days prior notice from the first working day after submission. NOTE: complex outages may require more notice.
- Doyon Utilities will notify the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) at least two weeks prior to any routine work requiring service interruption.
- Doyon Utilities will provide the Contractor with a list of affected buildings. The Contractor is responsible for notifying building occupants a minimum of 48 hours before the scheduled outage.
- Doyon Utilities will schedule and notify affected customers in the event that the outages are due to repairs for which Doyon Utilities is conducting.
